

Bob and Thelma Webber Scholarship

Purpose:

The Bob and Thelma Webber Scholarship is awarded annually to a graduating senior from Herscher High School who demonstrates strong academic achievement, leadership skills, and a commitment to pursuing higher education in the fields of **business** or **education**. This scholarship honors the legacy of Bob and Thelma Webber, who valued education, leadership, and lifelong learning.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. **Graduation from Herscher High School** – Applicant must be a current senior at Herscher High School.
2. **Field of Study** – Must plan to pursue a degree in **business** or **education** at an accredited college or university.
3. **Academic Excellence** – GPA, class rank
4. **Leadership and Involvement** – Must demonstrate leadership through school activities, community service, clubs, athletics, or other extracurricular activities.
5. **Character and Work Ethic** – Must exhibit integrity, perseverance, and a strong commitment to personal and academic growth.

Application

Students will apply for this award through the Community Foundation of Kankakee River Valley's Scholarship Portal.

Selection Process:

A scholarship committee will review all applications and select a recipient based on the outlined criteria. Financial need may be considered but is not the primary determining factor.

Award Amount:

A one-time scholarship award will be granted to the selected recipient and applied toward tuition, books, or other educational expenses.
